Irises that rebloom need a bit more care than the single bloomers. They need fertilizer and water more often to keep them from going dormant. Come to the January CBRIS meeting to find out how to double or triple your iris garden enjoyment with rebloomers. Be sure to take notes of the rebloomers that you like, so you can add them to your iris collection.
