## **Dahout's Digs**

### September 2020

Much was accomplished in August, in spite of COVID. We had a very successful rhizome sale at Yamagami's Nursery, followed by an always fun rhizome sale at Elaine Fischer's, followed by our annual potting party at my house, minus breakfast. We potted 100 tall bearded and 26 medians for next years' sales.

There will be a zoom Board Meeting, prior to our zoom General Meeting on Friday, September 4<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 pm. We will go over the preliminary budget and the calendar year for 2020-2021.

If you have not yet run Zoom, and would like to, please let me know and I will help you get set up. Here are some tips:

- 1. You need to locate the zoom controls. If you are on a computer, they are always arrayed around the edges. If you are on an iPad or iPhone, you may need to tap the screen to get the controls visible. They only stay up for a few seconds.
- 2. In the bottom left hand corner (or along the top on an iPad) you will see Mute/Unmute (a microphone icon) and Start Video/Stop Video (a camera icon). These are your local controls and they determine if others in the meeting can hear or see you. They are both toggles, meaning click it once and it changes state, click it again and you are back to where you started. So if you are currently muted and you click it, you become unmuted (you can be heard), click it again and you will become muted again.
- 3. If there is a red line through the microphone, you are currently muted.
- 4. If there is a red line through the camera, no one can see you. Your image is black and only shows your name to other attendees.
- 5. Along the bottom of the screen (or along the top on an iPad) is a Chat icon. This is a text based message board which exists only for this session. You can see what others are chatting about and you can send your own message

If you want to know who else is in the session, you can bring up the list by clicking "Participants" along the bottom of your controls. —Carol Dahout, CBRIS Co-President

## **September Culture**

How many of you have your newly acquired irises planted? How many of you are redoing your iris beds? It is time to get busy if you still have rhizomes lying about. In our area you are okay to plant throughout the month of September. The rhizomes need at least six weeks of growth before cold weather sets in. (Yes, I did say cold weather! It will come again believe it or not.) You do need to work on those iris beds now. The most common mistakes made with planting rises is planting too deep or not giving them enough sun. The minimum amount is six hours a day. More is better.

- Amend the clay soil with compost and a bit of even numbered fertilizer. Some gardeners add oyster shell, coarse sand, gypsum, or unsalted alpha pellets to their soil. Some add a small amount of superphosphate or a small amount of bone meal. We all have our little tricks and ideas. A minimum of compost and fertilizer will do just fine.
- 2. Dig planting holes about 18 inches apart. Build a small mound of soil in the center of the planting hole
- 3. Center the rhizome in the mound, roots down, and then bury the rhizome, leaving the top slightly exposed.
- 4. Firm the soil around the roots. Water thoroughly. Continue watering a few times a week until new leaves show growth. Once established the irises do not need regular watering.
- 5. Keep weed free. —Excerpts from https://www.americanmeadows.com/planting-bearded-iris
